

Dear FCCS Consultant Candidate:

Thank you for your interest in becoming a consultant in the Society of Critical Care Medicine's Fundamental Critical Care Support (FCCS) program. The criteria to become an FCCS Consultant require that the candidate:

- Be an SCCM-approved FCCS Course Director in good standing
- Have taught/directed at least two approved FCCS courses in the two previous years
- Be willing to offer mentorship and guidance to first-time Course Directors and Coordinators
- Submit a completed FCCS Consultant application via attached online form
- Submit an FCCS Consultant Letter of Recommendation via attached form

As an FCCS Consultant, it will be your responsibility to mentor new Course Directors and review their abilities and skills to determine if they should be permitted to manage further courses without Consultant supervision.

The criteria to maintain the role of Consultant require that the candidate:

- Maintain SCCM membership status
- Continue certification, special/added qualification, or practice ratio in critical care
- Offer mentorship and guidance to first time Course Directors and Coordinators
- Attend at least one day of a Course Director candidate's first course
- Evaluate the process, venue, and attitudes of course faculty
- Confer with Course Director and Course Coordinator after the course to complete an evaluation for SCCM
